

AN ORDER OF SERVICE

FOR PRIMARY CLASSES OR THE HOME LESSON

First Quarter, 1912

I. RECITE. The Golden Text for the Quarter. Give a brief explanatory remark each Sunday.

II. PRAYER, giving special thanks for "Jesus, the Light of the World".

III. SINGING. Hymn 550, Book of Praise, or "Jesus bids us shine".

IV. OFFERING. Recite or sing :

"We bring now our gifts to the Master,
Although they are small they'll be blest ;
He knows we are tiny disciples,
But loves us as well as the rest."

V. SINGING. One or more hymns. Let these be selected sometimes by the children.

VI. THE QUESTION ON MISSIONS FOR THE DAY. (See each Lesson.) The very little ones will not be expected to learn this by heart, but it may be repeated several times over, and any needed explanation given.

VII. RECITE :

"Winter day ! Frosty day !
God a cloak on all doth lay ;
On the earth the snow He sheddeth,
O'er the lamb a fleece He spreadeth,
Gives the bird a coat of feather
To protect it from the weather,
Gives the children home and food ;
Let us praise Him ; God is good."

VIII. SUPPLEMENTAL LESSON. Learn and repeat Scripture Memory Passage. For those under six, The Lambs of the Flock, Mark 10 : 13-16. For those under eleven, The Child Wonderful, Isa. 9 : 6. (A pretty Certificate in colors is awarded for the correct recitation of all the verses in the List of Passages For Those Under Six ; and a larger Certificate for the correct recitation of the complete List of Passages For Those Under Eleven.)

IX. SINGING. Hymn 520, Book of Praise, vs. 1 and 2. (These are the first two verses of the Supplemental Hymn for the Half Year. The verses should be learned one by one. As the little ones sing them Sunday after Sunday, they will soon come to know them by heart.)
