

Government, as by Law happily established in this Province," continued by the Act of the 49th, Geo. 3, chap. 1, will expire with the present Session.

The Act passed in the forty eighth year of His Majesty's reign, chap. 11, intituled "An Act for applying a certain sum therein mentioned, to make good a like sum issued and advanced in pursuance of an Address of the House of Assembly, and for the relief of Insane persons, and for the support of Foundlings;" will expire 1st of April, 1811.

The Act passed in the forty third year of His Majesty's reign, chap. 2, intituled, "An Act for establishing regulations respecting Aliens and certain subjects of His Majesty, who have resided in *France*, coming into this Province or residing therein," continued by the Act of the 49th Geo: 3. chap. 4, will expire with the present Session.

The Act passed in the forty eighth year of His Majesty's reign, chap. 7th intituled, "An Act to permit the Provincial Courts of Appeals to be holden and kept in such place as the Governor shall appoint;" will expire with the present Session.

The Act passed in the thirty ninth year of His Majesty's reign, chap. 6, intituled, "An Act to provide Houses of Correction in the several Districts of this Province," and the Act passed in the 42d, Geo. 3d, chap. 6, intituled, "An Act further to continue and amend an Act passed in the thirty-ninth year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act to provide Houses of Correction in the several Districts of this Province;" continued by the Act of the 46th, Geo. 3d, chap 6, will expire with the present Session.
