

PROCLAMATION.

A. MUSGRAVE. (L. S.) VICTORIA, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith.

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

WHEREAS it is Our will and pleasure to issue Our Writ for the Election of ONE Member to serve in the General Assembly of Our Island of Newfoundland, for the WESTERN DIVISION of the Electoral District of ST. JOHN'S, in the room of JOHN CASEY, Esquire, whose seat, as Member of the General Assembly of Our said Island, has become vacant by reason of his having accepted the Office of Chairman of the Board of Works, being an office of Emolument from the Crown, under the Act, "providing for the vacation of Seats of Members in certain cases, &c.," We do, therefore, by these presents, make known unto all Our loving subjects, within the aforementioned Division of St. John's West, that the Election of ONE Member to serve in the said General Assembly, shall be held at St. John's, Petty Harbor, and Broad Cove. within the said Division. And that such Election shall be completed within the period of ten complete days from the day of the receipt by the Returning Officer, for the said Division, of Our Writ authorising such Election.

And We do further order and direct that the Nomination of Candidates shall take place on Monday Twenty eighth May instant, and the Polls shall be taken on Saturday the Second June following, in the said Division; and that the said Election shall be conducted in conformity to the regulations, orders, and directions contained, and set forth in Our Proclamations, bearing date, respectively, the Nineteenth and Twenty-
