

Major Walter Eyre Curry

Born, February 28, 1891

Died, April 9, 1917

Joined 2nd Regiment (Queen's Own Rifles of Canada), as Lieutenant, January 20, 1911. Appointed Lieutenant, 3rd Battalion, C.E.F., September 22, 1914. Served in France with 3rd Battalion and returned to Canada on Sick Leave, being retained for duty, October 1, 1915. Appointed Lieutenant, 83rd Battalion, October 1, 1915. Promoted Captain, October 20, 1915, and Major, January 17, 1916. Proceeded to England with 83rd Battalion. Reverted to Captain in order to return to France, rejoining the 3rd Battalion in France, July 1, 1916. Appointed Acting-Major, November 19, 1916. Killed in Action by shell, Vimy Ridge, France. Buried in Ecoibres Military Cemetery, France.
