ing more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America," and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province, and by the authority of the same, That from and out of the rates and duties already raised, levied and collected, or hereafter to be raised, levied and collected, to and for the purposes of paying the Salaries of the Officers of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, and for defraying the Contingent Expences thereof, and to and for the uses of this Province, there be granted to his Majesty the sum of two thousand two hundred and sifty sive pounds sive shillings, to be issued out of the Provincial Fund in the Receiver General's hands to the uses hereaster expressed, and defray the sollowing expences, that is to say,

For Services rendered previous to the present Session of Parliament as follows:

The Clerk of the Legislative Council, one hundred and forty-five pounds.

The Uther of the Black Rod, fifty pounds.

The Matter in Chancery attending the Legislative Council, fifty pounds.

The Chaplain of the Legislative Council, thirty pounds.
