Synopsis of Coal Mining Regulations.

COAL MINING RIGHTS of the Dominion in Manitoba, Saskatchewan, and the Yukon Territory, the Northwest Territories, and a portion of the Province of British Columbia.

Application for a lease must be made by the applicant in person to the Agent of Sub-Agent of the district in which the lease is desired.

The person operating the mine shall furnish the Agent with sworn returns accounting for the full quantity of merchantable coal mined and pay the royalty thereon.

For full information application should be made to the Secretary of the Department of the Interior, Ottawa, or to any Agent or Sub-Agent of Dominion Lands.

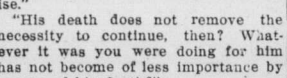

CAPABLE WOMEN AND WHAT THEY ARE DOING

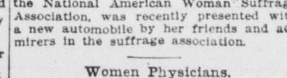
