Our readers will be pained to learn that the Rev. G. H. Gordon and his wife, missionaries of the Presbyterian Church of the Lower Province of Erromanga, have been cruelly murdered by the natives of that island.

The particulars of the murder, which took place on the 20th of May last, will be found in the following letter written by a gentleman on Erromanga, and addressed to the Rev. William Guthrie, of Sydney, Australia, who published it in the Sydney Morning Herald.

Erromanga, 7th June, 1861.

Rev. Sir,—It is with feelings of deep melancholy that I now have to communicate to you the distressing intelligence of the death of your worthy missionary and his wife, Mr. and Mrs. Gordon.

This mournful event took place on the 20th ultimo, about one o'clock in the afternoon, and in the act of writing a note to Mr. Gordon, who was started by a native (David) who followed by others of the Mission party, and who had been armed with spears and clubs.
