

With the Emperor Frederict III, in the middle of the fifteenth century, Austrian ascendency in Eu-rope begins. Characteristically, this ruler, who was beaten in all his wars, laid the cornerstone of the glory that was to come. His son, Maximilian, one of the most bril-liant rulers in European history, while making the prestige and mach-inery of the Hely koman Empire an appendage of Austrian grandeur, Inery of the Half Koman Empire an appendage of Austrian grandeur, also founded Hapsburg world power in the treaties which insured his house the succession to the domains of Burgundy, Spain, Hungary and Bohemia. His grandson, Charles V, German King, Roman Emperor, was also the ruler of Snain, the Netheralso the ruler of Spain, the Netheralso the future of spain, the vectori-lands, the larger part of Italy and the Americas. But the consolidation of the future Hapsburg realm was accomplished by Charles' brother, Ferdinand, King of Hungary and Bohemia and Archduke of the Austrias.

Austrias. The century preceding the Treaty of Westphalia in 1648 received its stamp from two great historic cu-rents, one, the Reformation, the other the aspiration of the House of Austria for continental supremacy. In the first decade of the Thirty Years' War, from 1620 to 1630, this aspiration was realized in full. Bo-hemia was crushed by the imperial armies, Deannark and the North German princes were humiliated, and for a brief time even the Baltie became an Austrian lake. The cause ustrian lake. of Roman Catholicism was saved or Konian Carnolicism was saved on the verge of catastrophe by the triumph of Austria. 
