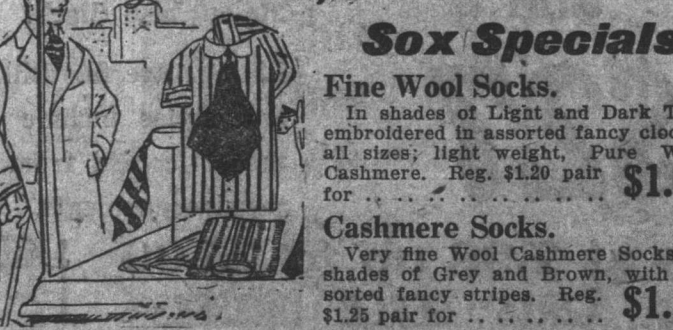

Even Thrill is Final Clinch in "Fast Mail"

Featured Players End Melodrama With Fadeout Kiss, Seated on Limb of Tree.

Charles Jones and Ellen Percy in "The Fast Mail" at the Majestic Theatre this week, end the picture by kissing out on the limb of a tree, thereby arousing the astonishment of the spectator, even though he knows a picture must wind up in a kiss, preferably in some unusual position. For earlier in the course of this Wm. Fox adaptation of Lincoln J. Carter's old melodrama they have gone through so many perils, especially in the case of Jones, that one would imagine that they would choose some other place for osculation instead of going high up in a tree.

Jones, in chasing the plot all over the map, rides a horse which leaps over a railroad gate just in time to avoid being pushed over by the express; jumps lightly from the fast mail to a speeding automobile, and from one Mississippi steamboat to another, swings out over a telegraph wire with the heroine clinging to his legs to escape a realistic fire, and altogether has as busy a day as a man can have and still remain fairly intact. Never mind the details of the story, which begin with a steppelchase and ends with an exciting hotel conflagration, which, however, doesn't stop the villain inside from trying his usual dirty work. Suffice to say that Jones does all these stunts—or appears to do them, for the picture moves at such a breathless pace one can't tell whether he uses a double, thereby saving one from worrying over such a detail. The hero continually shows wonderful wearing qualities, for in addition to these little problems the director occasionally stacks him up against slashing fights.

American Physician Will Take Drug and Become a Savage

DR. SCHNEIDER TO GIVE THE STORY OF HIS SENSATIONS.

(By Canadian Press) Berkeley, Calif.—The reaction of a drug known as "kasapl," reputed to unchain fierce impulses of the subconscious mind and transform its user into a raging savage, bereft of timidity, fear or the veneer of civilization, upon a university professor, is to be tested by Dr. Albert Schneider, lecturer at the University of California, according to an announcement made here by Dr. Schneider.

The new drug is said to have been obtained from savage tribes inhabiting the jungles at the headwaters of the Amazon and to have been brought to this country by Dr. H. H. Russell, a dean of the New York College of Pharmacy.

Dr. Schneider declared he intended to take some of the serum soon after his return to his home in Portland and later give to the whole world the story of his sensations while under the influence of the drug. He is dean of the North Pacific College of Portland and prominent as a psychiatrist.
