Our Dumb Animals.

Report Of The Chief Agent, Week Ending Sept. 5th, 1924.

Attended to the landing of 43 head of cattle, and nineteen sheep, from the Lager County, also four car loads of cattle from the railway station, two sales of cattle from the Abattoir Coy's premises. I am very thankful to Messrs. Bartlett, Godden and Tobin for the great care taken in landing cattle from the steamer, as she is exceptionally high and they do all possible for the comfort of the cattle. I have asked the Agent for a box to land the cows. This will be useful for landing sheep and calves. I was called to Mount Royal Avenue to shoot a young setter which had been run over on Mundy Pond Road by the owner, Mr. Bartlett. My attention has been called to the great cruelty displayed by young people towards cats. A lady was coming out Topsail Road in a motor, when a little girl threw a kitten underneath the motor. The car didn't strike it. The lady stopped and enquired why she did it. She said the woman up at the house sent her to do it. I would have summoned her for cruelty if the kitten was hurt. Another case occurred at Rennie's River where children were sent to drown a cat. They couldn't drown it, so they put it on the river bank and beat it with sticks until they killed it. This is only two of many cases. Evidently these children need education and refining influences. I believe that Human Education will have to be taught in all our schools, for there is a great need of it to-day, with the children who are growing up. I think the Boy Scouts and Girl Guides will have to take an active part in making things better. I have been asked by the Expressmen to ask all housewives and others to leave their orders for their groceries and other things on Fridays or Saturday mornings. Drivers' horses see get home on Sunday mornings and the buying public are responsible. By the time the horse is brought to pasture it is between one and two before the driver reaches his home on Sunday morning. I think shopping could be done Fridays or earlier. Attended the Court House re a case of a man who struck a cow with a motor on Petty Harbor Road. He didn't know the leg was broken at the time of the accident. But he acted very honorably and paid the owner of the cow \$80 dollars. Seeing it was his first offence the Judge dismissed the case. Twenty different complaints have been attended to during the week. Will the public help me by their influence and moral support to see that the animals all get a square deal, and phone me all complaints?
