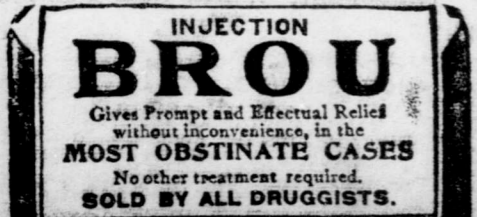

Calgary, Alta., April 22.—Luther McCarty, white heavyweight champion of the world, today accepted terms to come to Calgary to fight on May 24.

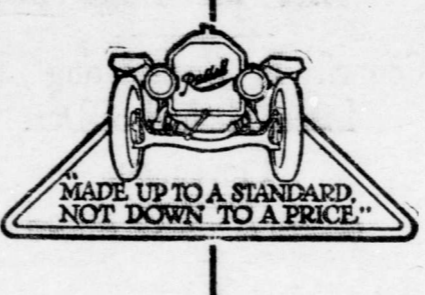

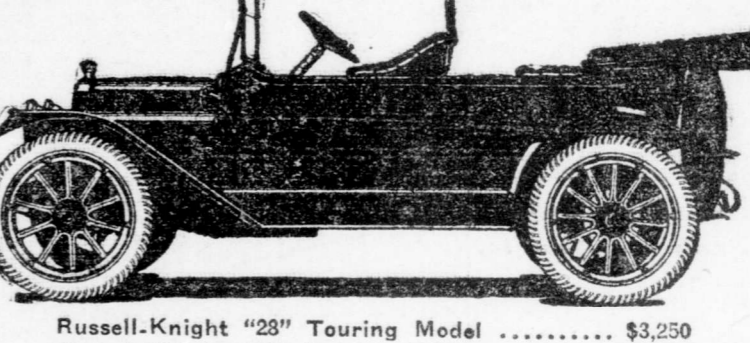
