## Flint Wins First From London In Eleventh, 5-4

FLINT, Aug. 14.—After having the game almost won, London allowed the Flint VEHICLES to tie the score with four runs in the eighth and then let them have another marker in the 11th frame to win, 5 to 4.

## Ontario Government SURE WINNER AT RACES

TORONTO, Aug. 14.—The Toronto Telegram today prints an interview with A. M. Orpen, which says:

"Dark days lie ahead of those interested in thoroughbred racing in Ontario. There are two on the horizon, the Ontario Jockey Club and the Ontario Thoroughbred Racing Association, which today said that the recent meeting at this track had resulted in a deficit of approximately \$15,000."

"As conditions now stand," he says, "no matter who may lose a race meeting, the Government is bound to win."

"Take our last gathering at Royal York, for instance. Our total receipts for the seven days were \$24,955. Of this amount the Ontario Thoroughbred Racing Association took \$15,000 for daily operation tax, \$83,000 commission on money wagered and \$7,000 for war tax administration tickets and passes, a total of \$142,955."
