#### Duke's Private Income.

Thamesville, May 8.—John Bert died on Wednesday of blood poisoning. About two weeks ago Mr. Bert was scratched by a fowl. The mark was hardly perceptible, but blood poisoning set in and he became very ill, suffering great pain the past week. Mr. Bert was well and favorably known in this vicinity for a great many years, He resided in Howard, where, in addition to farming, he followed his trade as carpenter. After the death of his wite, about two years ago, he moved to town and has since lived with his son. He leaves three daughters and one son, Mrs. Martin, of Detroit; Mrs. Henry Secord and Mrs. Geo.
