1. Last day for Treasurers to furnish Bureau of Industries, on form furnished by Depart-
ment, statistics regarding finances of their municipalities.—Municipal Act, Sec. 252.
Last day for passing by-laws to alter School Section boundaries.—Public School Act,
Section 81.
County Treasurers to complete and balance their books, charging lands with arrears of
taxes.—Assessment Act, Section 152.
Liquor Licenses to be dated from Liquor License Act, section 8.
3. Arbor Day.
15. Last day for issuing Tavern and Shop Licenses.—Liquor License Act, section 8.
Contents of earth closets to be removed on or before this date.—Public Health Act,
schedule A, rule 2 of section 14.
24. Queen's Birthday.
31. Last day for issuing Wholesale Liquor Licenses.—Liquor License Act, section 8.

JUNE.

1. Public and Separate School Boards to appoint representatives on the High School
Entrance Examination Board of Examiners.—H. S. Act, section 38 (2).
20. Earliest day upon which statute labor to be performed in unincorporated Townships.—
Assessment Act, section 113.
