

Trade Agreement Between the Dominion of Canada and  
The Irish Free State

The Majesty's Government in the Dominion of Canada and His Majesty's Government in the Irish Free State, desiring to facilitate and extend their trading and industrial relations of trade and commerce, have agreed upon the following

Article I

Goods the produce or manufacture of Canada, imported into the Irish Free State, shall not be subject to other or higher duties than those to which the produce or manufacture of any other country

Article II

Goods the produce or manufacture of the Irish Free State, imported into Canada, shall not be subject to other or higher duties than those to which the produce or manufacture of any other country
