

(a) Thailand shall issue to the credit of each trainee in Thailand such pay and allowances, according to his rank, as he may be entitled to receive under Thai regulations. The Thai authorities will assume responsibilities for arrangements such as assignments or deductions from such pay and allowances, which may be required to meet such obligations as the support of a trainee's dependents in Thailand. A trainee may make private arrangements to draw upon any balance of such pay and allowances remaining to his credit to meet his personal expenses while in Canada, if and to the extent that such arrangements are permitted by the Thai authorities. Pay and allowances issued by Thailand shall be exempt from Canadian taxation.

(b) Allowances payable in accordance with Article 3 shall be issued by Canada to each trainee, to meet his living and other expenses during his period of training, as follows:

(i) a Maintenance Allowance at a rate appropriate to the trainee's rank,

(ii) a Clothing Allowance if the trainee is in Canada for at least two months or during the winter season (October to April),
