DECLARATIONS MADE BY CANADA PERTAINING TO ITS ACCESSION TO THE UNITED NATIONS CONVENTION ON CONTRACTS FOR THE INTERNATIONAL SALE OF GOODS, CONCLUDED AT VIENNA ON APRIL 11, 1980

The Government of Canada declares, in accordance with Article 93 of the Convention, that in addition to the provinces of Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, Nova Scotia, Ontario, Prince Edward Island, the Northwest Territories, Quebec and Saskatchewan, the Convention shall extend to the Yukon Territory.

The Government of Canada declares that the declaration made at the time of its accession to the Convention and the declaration deposited on April 9, 1992 remain in effect.
