leevelopment is evident in our bilateral, regional and EXPECTED OUTCOME integrated trade and environment decision making, including preambular language and environmentrelated provisions in agreements, broader environmental objectives, and obligations in parallel agreements as appropriate. Canadian leadership on implementation of the Agreement's framework to better conserve, protect and enhance the North American environment through cooperation and effective enforcement of environmental laws. improved decision making by exporters on sustainable transportation options. improved integration of environmental considerations into CCC involvement in foreign projects to ensure consideration of environmental factors. OECD Council endorsement of improved guidelines for environmental procedures and standards applied to projects financed by export credit agencies. identification of partners for international research and development collaboration, attraction of capital investment needed to complete development, and increased trade in innovative, pollution-reducing and energy-efficient Canadian products and services. increased private sector participation in the implementation of CDM & JI projects.
