## PRAYERS

Mr. Portelance, from the Standing Committee on Labour, Manpower and Immigration, presented the Third Report of the Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Monday, February 24, 1975, your Committee has considered the Votes under Labour in the Estimates for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1976 and reports the same.

Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Rodriguez, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-389, An Act to amend the

Canada Elections Act (political affiliation), which was read the first time and ordered to be printed and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

With reference to the answer to Question No. 46 of the Second Session of the 29th Parliament, which states in part that a total of \$2,646,315 was allocated under the Local Initiatives Programme for 1972-73 in the constituency of Westmount, Quebec (a) what are the names of all projects involved along with their addresses and the names and addresses of those signing the applications (b) in each case what is a detailed description of the actual project, specifically including the functions performed under the project?

2. What are the names and addresses of all persons or organizations who recommended each project in any manner whatsoever to the Department?—Sessional Paper No. 301-2/58.
