

Lobbyists and/or their employers could be required to disclose:

- a) names of clients;
- b) nature of the lobbying activity;
- c) a record of news articles undertaken by the lobbyist;
- d) names of public servants and Members of Parliament that the lobbyist dealt with on a particular matter;
- e) financial information.

Witnesses referred to us that if a registered lobbyist requires the
 registrant to disclose too many details then the system may break down as it
 attempts to cope with the amount of information being submitted. Also, whatever
 information is registered would be presented in a clear, concise form so that those
 who wish to study the disclosure records may easily understand the nature of the
 activity being recorded.
