unity constituting the nation and the higher institutions.

The head must remain the head but one must not neglect the fingers.

The head must remain the head, and no longer neglect the arms.

That is what everybody admits in principle, in abstracto, in the conception of ideas; but most of all, that is what facts must express in concrete action, in present monetary, economic and political terms by present governments, by present ministers, by the present Minister of Finance, who controls and holds all monetary, economic and political machinery as regards money circulation, that means of exchange, that social instrument which is used for all transactions between men in the material, intellectual and spiritual fields nowadays.

All this renovation of leadership toward the progress of the unit, of the human person, of the individual as a component part of the whole can and must be carried out within the regular frameworks of our present monetary, economic and political machinery, within the framework of free enterprises, of private property, under the powerful and able leadership of a truly democratic government, that is devoutly dedicated to the service of the people while protecting the interests and capital of large private enterprises.

A careful study of the program I am introducing today under the title "Personal Vital Right", will be sufficient to convince the most apprehensive masters and the most fervent devotees of our present tradition.

That is the central point of all consolidation of acquired wealth.

The "Personal Vital Right" is a simple technique, a very simple formula of administration which requires no new legislation, no new institution, no new mechanism; it can be worked out within the normal monetary, economical and political mechanisms used at present.
