Unmatured debt

Total unmatured debt of \$29,038 million is \$1,779 million more than at March 31, 1972.

The government's holdings of its own securities as at March 31, 1973 are comprised of \$56 million in the securities investment account, which represent Canada savings bonds held in respect of the employees instalment purchase plan. This is a decrease of \$4 million over the previous year-end total, when holdings were \$45 million in the securities investment account in respect of the employees instalment purchase plan and \$15 million in investment held for retirement of unmatured debt.

Of the total unmatured debt, \$28,704 million is payable in Canadian dollars, \$260 million is payable in U.S. dollars and \$74 million is payable in German deutsche marks. Securities payable in U.S. dollars are converted at U.S. \$1.00 = CAN. \$1.08108 and those payable in Deutsche Marks are converted at D.M. 3.66 = CAN. \$1.08108.

Summary of security issues, maturities, cancellations, conversions and redemptions

Excluding the refunding of treasury bills, the government will have issued securities in an amount of \$4,180 million and will have retired \$2,401 million.

Net sales of Canada savings bonds series 27 of \$2,003 million exceed redemptions of \$727 million by \$1,276 million bringing total Canada savings bonds to \$10,988 million at March 31, 1973.

Treasury bills of \$4,290 million are \$460 million more than at March 31, 1972 and consist of \$2,795 million in three-month bills, \$1,095 million in six-month bills and \$400 million in special bills.
