Sources of Stipend, in part: From Commutation Fund, 29; Ditto from another Diocese, 1; Col. and Con. Church Society, 5; Endowments and Congregations, 2; Curates, 3; Mission Fund alone, 24; Mission Fund and S. P. G. grant, 17; Indian Missionaries, 7; Teaching in Schools and Colleges, 5; Secretary Church Society, 1; Sustentation Fund, 1—95. Counted twice in above list, 5. Total, 90.

Thus, the Church Society is assisting, by the Mission Fund and S. P. G. 41; by Commutation Fund, 129; Sec. Church, 1; by the Sustentation Fund, 1. Total, 72.
