The following statistics with reference to the Clergy will be found interesting, as shewing to some extent the working of the Church Society:

Clergymen in the Diocese, Nov. 1st, 1870, 90—distributed as follows:—Incumbents or Missionaries, 71; Curates, 3; Missionaries to the Indians, 7; Secretary of the Church Society, 1; Agent for the Sustentation Fund, 1; Superannuated or Invalided, 2; Teachers in Colleges and Schools, 5 Total, 90.

Sources of Stipend, in part: From Commutation Fund, 29; Ditto from another Diocese, 1; Col. and Con. Church Society, 5; Endowments and Congregations, 2; Curates, 3; Mission Fund alone, 24; Mission Fund and S. P. G. grant, 17; Indian Missionaries, 7; Teaching in Schools and Colleges, 5; Secretary Church Society, 1; Sustentation Fund, 1—95. Counted twice in above list, 5. Total, 90.

Thus, the Church Society is assisting, by the Mission Fund and S. P. G.* 41; by Commutation Fund † 29; Sec. Church, 1; by the Sustentation Fund, 1. Total, 72.

Other sources of support: Commutation Fund from another Diocese, 1; Endowment and Congregations, 2; Curates paid by the Rector or the Congregation, 3; Colonial and Con. Church Socy, 5; Indian Missionaries, 7; Teaching in Colleges and Schools, 5—95. Counted twice, 5. Total, 90.

*Three Schoolmasters among the Indians, and 3 Interpreters, are also paid from the M. F.

†Besides these, 4 Clergymen who have moved into another Diocese are paid from this Fund.
