BILL S-11.

An Act to incorporate The Evangelical Mennonite Conference.

- Preamble.** WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:— 5
- Incorporation.** 1. David Plett Reimer, clergyman, of the postal district of Giroux, Archie Penner, clergyman, of the town of Steinbach, and Peter Loewen Friesen, clergyman, of the postal district of Morris, all in the province of Manitoba, are hereby incorporated under the name of The Evangelical 10
- Corporate name.** Mennonite Conference, hereinafter called "the Corporation", for the purposes set out in this Act and for the purpose of administering the property, business and other temporal affairs of the Corporation.
- Directors.** 2. The persons named in section 1 of this Act shall be 15 the first directors of the Corporation.
- Head office.** 3. (1) The head office of the Corporation shall be in the town of Steinbach, in the province of Manitoba, or at such other place as may be decided by the Corporation.
- Notice of change.** (2) Notice in writing shall be given to the Secretary of 20 State by the Corporation of any change of the head office and such notice shall be published forthwith in the *Canada Gazette*.
- Objects.** 4. The objects of the Corporation shall be (a) to promote, maintain, superintend and carry on in 25 accordance with the Christian faith, doctrines, constitution, acts and rulings of the Corporation any or all of the work of that body;
