



OUR DIPLOMA

This diploma, which is one of the most artistic ever printed in Canada, measures 21 x 24 inches and is printed in three colors, on high grade paper. It is semi-religious, historical, national and patriotic. On it appear the two greatest temples of Canada: The Cathedral of St. James the Major and Notre-Dame Church of Montreal; the Monuments of Mgr Laval and Champlain of Quebec, Jacques-Cartier, of St. Malo, France, and of Maisonneuve, Montreal. Two busts surmount the two columns of Fame: one, that of the inventor, Rev. Emile Duployé; the other that of M. Denis R. Perrault who has diffused the art in Canada. The cities of Montreal and Quebec appearing in the back ground produce a very beautiful effect, indeed. The Arts, Science, Industry and Commerce are symbolized. The Sacred Heart, French, British and Dominion flags throw their shadow over a goddess personifying stenography and type-writing.

A space is reserved for the name of the graduate as well as that of his school and of his teacher.
