

BY-LAWS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STEPHEN.

enacted by the Reeve and municipal council of Stephen, that from and after the passing of this by-law, any person or persons convicted of wilfully injuring or destroying any tree or trees or shrubs planted or preserved for shade or ornamental purposes, shall be fined at the discretion of the convicting justice, or imprisoned for a period not exceeding 10 days.

BY-LAW NO. IX, FOR 1882.

To make provision for the prevention of Nuisances and Immoralities within the Township of Stephen.

The municipal council of the township of Stephen by and under the authority of V. 36, Cap. 48, Sec. 379, enacts as follows:—

I. It shall not be lawful for any person or persons to sell or give any intoxicating drinks to any minor, without the consent of a parent, master or legal protector.

II, It shall not be lawful to put up any indecent placard, writing or pictures, or the writing of indecent words, or the making of indecent pictures or drawings on walls or fences in streets or public places.

III. It shall not be lawful for any person to be found drunk or guilty of any vice, profane swearing, obscene, blasphemous, insulting or grossly insulting language, or other immoralities or indecences.
