Mademoiselle won 1st prize at the "Royal Northern" and "The Ythanside" Shows, both as a yearling and two-year-old.

Her sire, Earl of Derby 2nd (91061), in 1874 won 1st prize at "The Formartine," and medal for best bull at "The Highland Society's" and at the "Royal Northern;" 1st prize,—Cup for best Short Horn, and Cup for best animal of any breed. Also, in 1875, at Inverness, he won 1st prize, Lochiel's Cup (£60), as best bull of any breed, and Sir Geo. McPherson Grant's prize for best breeding animal in the show-yard.

Her dam, Missie 47th, won 1st prize and Challenge Cup as best cow of any breed in a large class at "The Ythanside" Show in 1878.
