Cobalt - Heavy Liquidation Continues and Mining Stocks React Further

General Weakness in Cobalts Mining Stocks on Down Grade. Three Point Break in Rochester Follows Throwing Over of Large Block of Stock - Other Declines General.

Friday Evening, Dec. 16. There was no let-up whatever to the weaker trend to prices of the mining stocks on the local market to-day, the net continuing on the down grade throughout the session, and values losing anywhere from a large fraction to two and three points in most instances.

It was generally understood, however, that the decline was occasioned by the throwing over of 20,000 shares of option stock, which had not been taken up, and which was accordingly put on the market for what it would bring.

Acquitted.

Mrs. May Butler, 398 Parliament-street, was found not guilty in the sessions yesterday on a charge of stealing \$1 from Adolph Carroll, who was a guest at a Halloween party in her home.

According to Carroll's evidence he had laid his purse on a table while leaving the room for a moment and did not miss it till the next morning. It contained two fives and a one dollar bill, and was returned to him empty the next day by Mr. Butler, who said his wife found it in the baby's cot.
