## HONORING THE HEROIC DEAD

Dedication of the Mausoleum  
of Gen. Grant.

## NEW YORK IN GAYEST GARB

All Nature Smiled When Morning  
Broke After a Night of Tears.

No Expense Spared in Decorations for the  
Event to Which All American Has Been  
Looking.

The ceremonies began at ten  
o'clock in the unfolding of the flag pre-  
sented by the Daughters of the Revolution.  
—Address of President McKinley—  
Grandstand and Naval Pageants Ever-  
green in America.

New York, April 27.—Nature smiled  
after a night of tears when morning  
broke over the metropolis to-day.  
Fleecy clouds floated across the sky  
and a cool breeze caused the myriad  
flags of the city's decorations to flutter  
in the unfolding of the flag pre-  
sented by the Daughters of the Revolution.  
—Address of President McKinley—  
Grandstand and Naval Pageants Ever-  
green in America.

The city spared itself no expense  
in the number and variety of her de-  
corations. Flags and bunting are every-  
where in evidence, and the thousands  
who throng the streets are dressed in  
the gayest of holiday attire.  
All along the route of the great pa-  
rade there is scarcely an inch of avail-  
able space which has not been secured  
for observation purposes.

The ceremonies began at sunrise,  
when from the tall flagpole near the  
tomb of the illustrious American flag  
furnished by the Daughters of the Re-  
volution. There it will remain until  
day, through fair weather and  
foul, until the elements have faded its  
colors and worn it away. At the same  
time the signal to join in the pa-  
rade was being beaten into line of  
Red Hook, preparatory to its start at  
2 o'clock, when it would proceed on  
its way to join the White Squadron and  
foreign war vessels on the North River.

On the way to the Tomb.  
The initial step in the parade was  
made almost on schedule time, and  
by 9:40 o'clock the Presidential pro-  
cession was on the move.

The Presidential procession moved to  
the scene of the dedication, headed by  
squadron of Federal Cavalry, then  
President Hobart, Mayor Strong and  
General Porter occupied the first car-  
riage. Members of the military and  
naval staffs followed, after which came a carriage  
occupied by ex-President Cleveland  
and Richard Watson Gilder. Then the  
members of the Cabinet, the generals  
of the army and admirals of the navy.  
The diplomatic corps, Sir Julian  
Pauncefote, the British Ambassador,  
was under the wing of the  
General. Cheers greeted the dis-  
tinguished party as it moved through  
the decorated streets bounded by an  
unbroken wall of humanity six miles  
long. The arrival at the tomb was the  
signal for a most stupendous outburst  
of patriotic cheering from the 50,000  
people in the grand stands and on the  
lawn around the monument and on  
Clement Heights.

The musical exercises  
at the monument began at 10:30.  
At 11:25 President McKinley began  
his address.

The President's address was in  
part as follows:  
Fellow Citizens.—A great life dedi-  
cated to the welfare of the nation  
here finds its early and noble end. Even  
if this day lacked the impressiveness  
of ceremony and was devoted to pagan-  
try, it would still be memorable, be-  
cause it is the anniversary of the birth  
of one of the most famous and best  
loved of American soldiers. Archibald  
has paid tribute to the leaders of  
mankind, but never was more grate-  
fully accepted by a free people than  
the beautiful structure before which  
we are now gathered.

The President spoke of the repre-  
sentation of foreign nations and of sov-  
ereign States who were present at the  
ceremony, and, continuing, said: "Al-  
most twelve years have elapsed since  
the heroic vigil ended and the brave  
spirit of Ulysses S. Grant fearlessly  
faced the light. The signal was given  
and he preceded him, but of the mighty  
captains of the great war Grant was  
first to be called to the other shore.

## FEARFUL FIRE AT NEWPORT NEWS

One and a Half Million Dollars Worth of  
Shipping Property Swept Away—  
Some Narrow Escapes.

Newport News, Va., April 27.—Fire  
broke out at Pier No. 5 of the Ches-  
apeake & Ohio Railway Company to-  
day, and before the flames were con-  
tained under control piers 5 and 6, crowd-  
ed with valuable merchandise, had  
gone up in smoke, and the Chesapeake  
& Ohio tug Waverider and the half-  
toned German barque J. D. Blackford  
were burned to the water's edge. The  
Norwegian steamship Solvay was  
badly damaged and the British steam-  
ship Clintonia completely destroyed  
by the flames. Several other steamers,  
which had steam up, were able to get  
out of harm's way.

The crew of the tug Waverider had  
a narrow escape from a horrible  
death. Their craft was on fire before  
they were awakened by the alarm.  
The tug immediately tried to effect its  
escape and ran around to the south side  
of Pier 5, but was unable to do so.  
The flames were so intense that the tug

the crew to escape. E. R. Digg, a  
deck hand; John Digg, the second  
mate, and a colored man named Tom  
were the only survivors.
