Financial assistance was committed on May 18, 1973 under Section 1(d) of the Canada/Manitoba Special Rural Development Agreement, dated July 20, 1971, as follows: "The development of viable supplementary or alternative primary producing activities for the purpose of improving marginal or submarginal incomes of disadvantaged people engaged in such activities."

Financial assistance was committed August 8, 1974 under Section 1(e) of the Canada/Manitoba Special Rural Development Agreement, dated July 20, 1971, as follows: "The establishment, expansion or modernization of any commercial undertaking engaged in the utilization of primary resources, in processing, in manufacturing or in the provision of services; including tourist facilities, provided that: (i) the undertaking is expressly organized so that at least two-thirds of those employed are disadvantaged people who have previously had little or no access to regular earning and employment opportunities; and (ii) there is adequate provision for such counselling, training and other adjustment, measures as are necessary to the employment of disadvantaged people in the undertaking."
