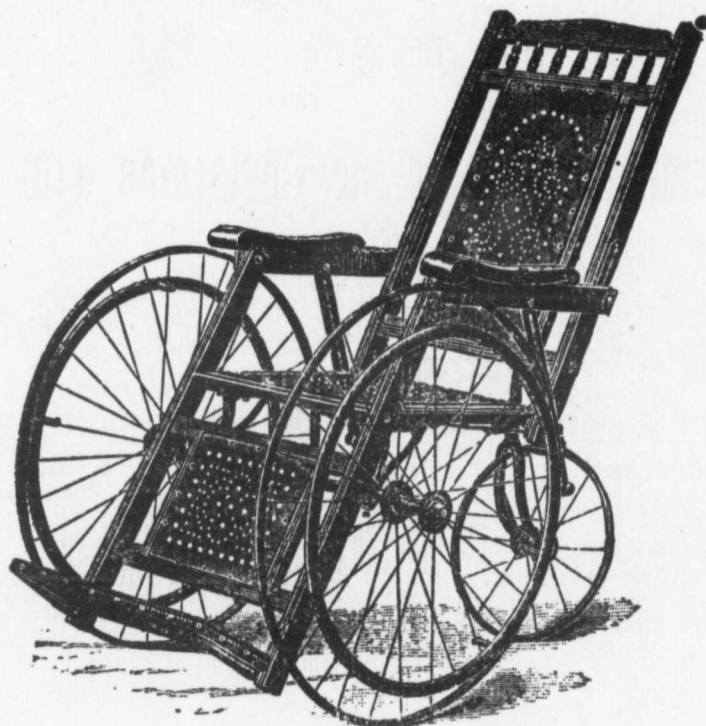


# AN INVALID CHAIR.
