The state of the s Extract of Minute of Meeting of Committee of Nova Scotia Auxiliary Bible Society, held on Monday, the 3rd day of October, 1864.

It being understood that each member of the Committee shall be entitled to give an order for a Bible or a Testament to any person whom he may think requires it.
