SKILLFUL WORK OF JAPS IN ENGL.

An English Which Consumed Five Years in Carving and is Valued at \$10,000—Tribute a Big Stock in Trade in the Country of the Mikado—A Gift to Chicago.

World's Fair, July 23—[Special.]—Japan has contributed splendidly to the World's Columbian exposition.

Seven years ago the artisans and producers of the Oriental empire made a display of their wares at Philadelphia, and were so much gratified by the reception which they met there with the market for their goods which was immediately opened up to the world.

Now for the first time since that epochal exhibition they have been able to repeat their effort at the Centennial, only this time in a more complete and more successful manner.

With a class of fine ware which is not often seen beyond the borders of their own country, the Japanese government has been able to make a liberal appropriation, and the manufacturers' associations of Yokohama, Nagasaki and other cities, corresponding closely to our boards of trade, and the associated companies, co-operated in the work.

The result is such a display of Japanese handwork and products as was never before seen on this continent.

Now for the first time the American people are given their first opportunity to see Oriental work that is really fine.
