GOOD THINGS TO EAT.

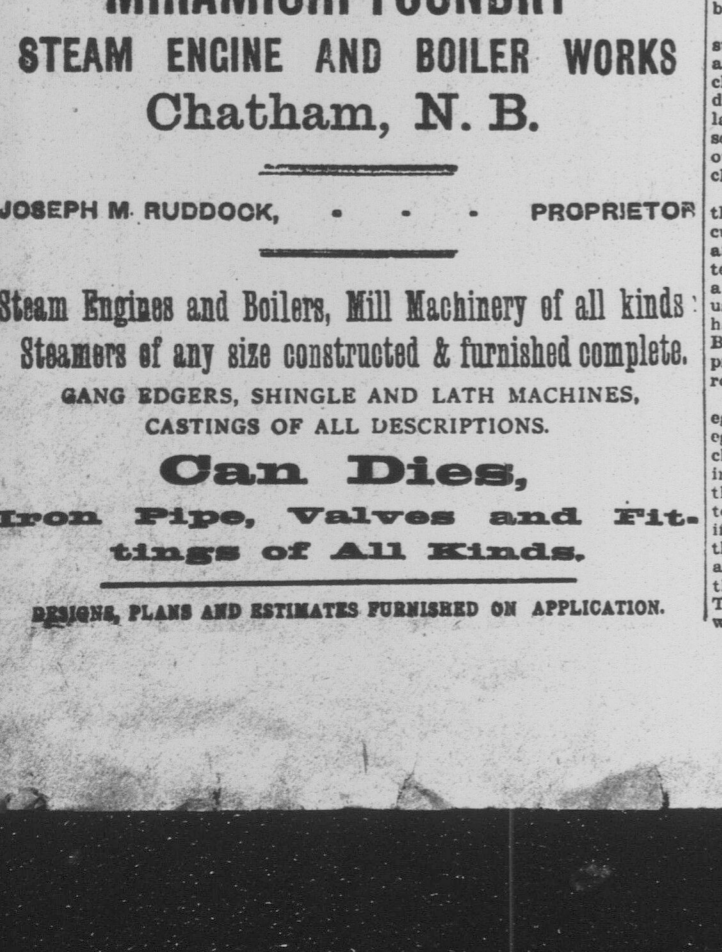
