In connection with a late report that a force of 20,000 English troops have been landed at Calais, Ostend and Dunkirk, and are now on their way to Namur, on the route to Leige, to reinforce the Belgians, a short account of Namur may be of interest.

Namur is a province in Belgium on the French border, is hilly and belongs to the basin of the Meuse. The section of the Meuse between Namur and Dinant is sometimes called Little Switzerland. Forests cover nearly one-third of the surface. The province is rich in minerals, iron and coal being the chief, with copper, lead, marble, slate and building stone. The manufactures include cutlery, earthenware, porcelain, glass, tanning and beer. It contains an area of 1,414 square miles and has a population of about 34,000. It is thirty-five miles southeast of Brussels. With the exception of the picturesque citadel the old fortifications have been razed since 1866, their place being taken by a cordon of seven forts. The town itself has suffered so much by war that it offers little of interest.
