Moved by the Rev. W. CASE, seconded by the Rev. W. M. HARVARD,—

1. *That the Report now read be received, and printed under the direction of the Missionary Committee.*

Moved by the Rev. J. EVANS, seconded by the Rev. EG'N RYERSON,—

2. *That the destitute situation of our Pagan Indians, and the numerous Providential openings which are inviting our attention to their case, should deeply interest every Christian, and lead us to use all the means in our power to send to them the glorious Gospel of the ever-blessed God.*

Moved by the Rev. D. P. KIDDER, of Rochester, seconded by the Rev. WM. SCOTT,—

3. *That the magnitude of the work in which we are engaged, and the number of difficulties which everywhere present themselves, should lead us to unite our exertions and our prayers, with a fixed determination, in reliance upon the Divine Blessing, to extend the conquests of Sacred Truth throughout the whole of our Land until all the wanderers in our western territory shall bow to the authority of our Lord and Saviour.*
