An Act further to amend the Act respecting the Protection of Navigable Waters.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. Subsection 1 of section 7 of the Act respecting the Pro-R.S.C., c. 91, 5 tection of Navigable Waters, chapter 91 of the Revised Statutes, s. 7 amended is hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:—

"(a.)
