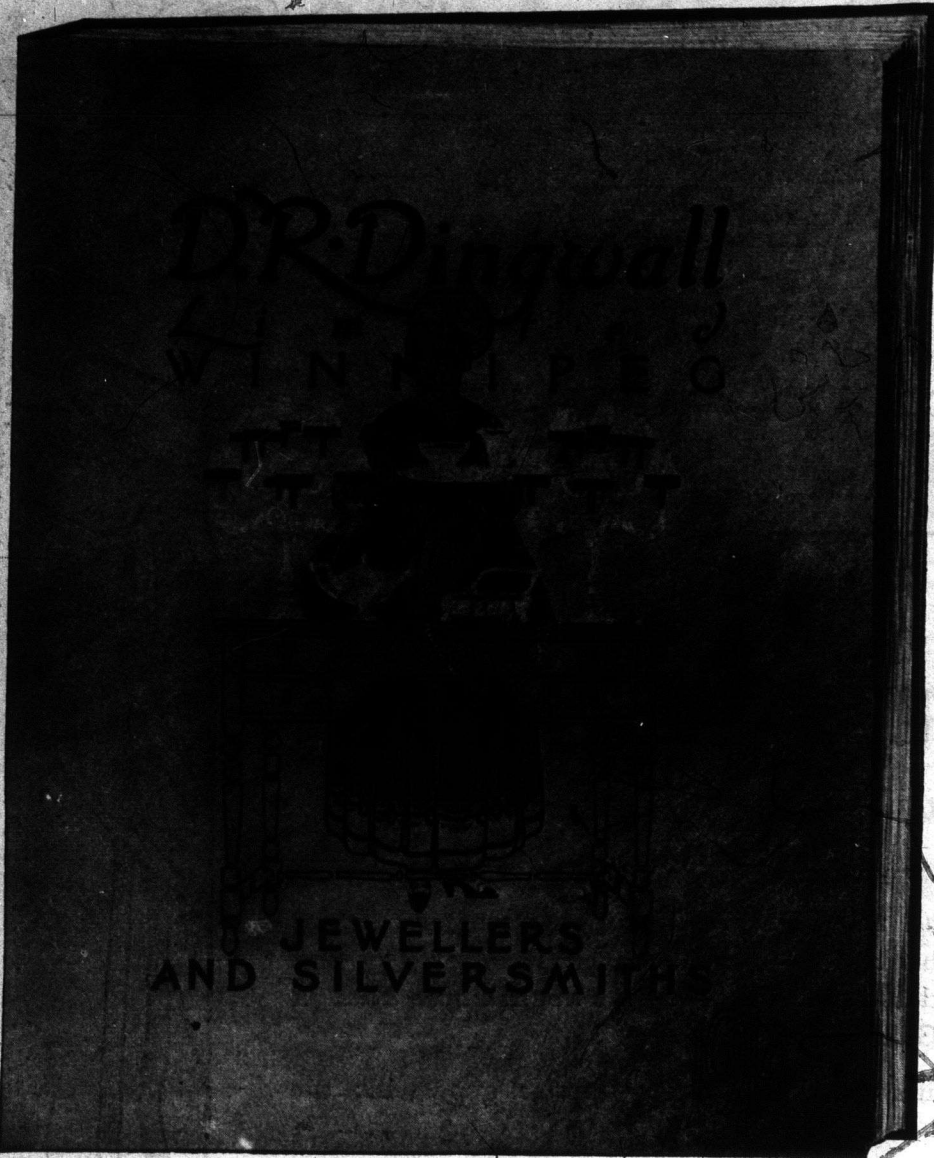




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Glenboro, Man., July 13, 1913.

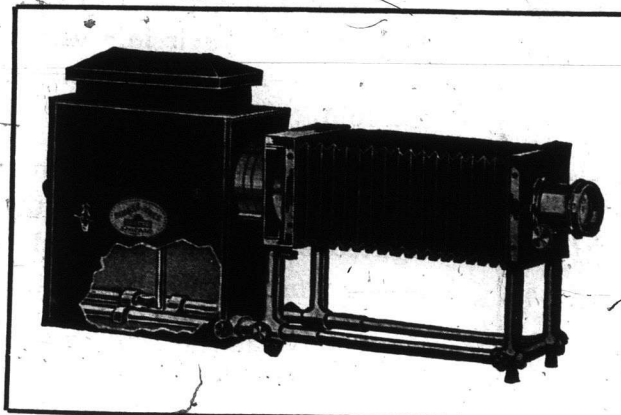
