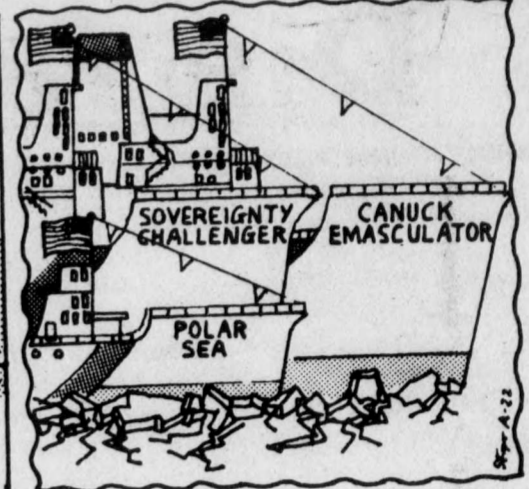


GOOD EVENING!

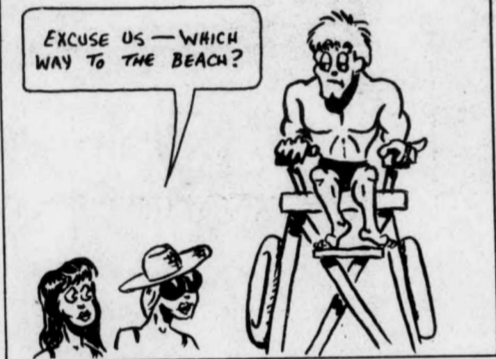
