I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter, of the 17th April last informing me of the existence of Small Pox on the South Shore of Lake Superior, and that in view of the danger of the Epidemics spreading to your District after the opening of Navigation when there are many Indians who have not yet been vaccinated, that you will be furnished with vaccine and lancets to vaccinate such Indians and in reply to inform you that as Dr Simpson of Manitowaning has been retained by the Department, to accompany Mr. Superintendent Plummer on his visit to pay the Indians Band within his Superintendency, their Annuitiy money, for the purpose of Vaccinating such of them as require it, I have thought proper to direct Dr Simpson to extend his visit to the localities indicated.
