

final Summary of Proceedings was completed. This procedure would have the advantage of avoiding flooding the Press with Reports on the last day of the Conference.

The Principal Delegates agreed:-

To approve in principle the advance publication of Reports of Committees of the Conference after they had received approval, subject to the agreement of the various Delegations being obtained as to which Reports, and how much of them, should be published.

5. A Press Communiqué was approved in the terms contained in Appendix II to the present Conclusions.
