I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 19th. What you say about A.G.Cardwell is noted. The desire of the Department remains as stat -ed in letter of the 15th instant , and is that all possible steps be taken for the comviction of those who are selling liquor to the Indians in nour Superintendency. From other sources it has come to appear that I have no doubt you are aware intoxicants are being too freely obtained by Indians along the coast of the Georgian Bay.
