
Ottawa 22nd April 1905

Sir:-

With reference to your letters of the 14th inst. No. 129 - B. I have to say that the Right of Way Agent of the Canadian Northern Railway has consented to pay on the basis of \$5.00 per acre for the Right of Way through the Valley River Reserve and \$30.00 damages to individual improvements. He is however having an investigation made of the claim of \$100.00 for the bridge destroyed before consenting to make this payment.

Hon Mr Laird has been asked to give his views as to what sum should be asked for the borrow-pit.
