The Department is forwarding a copy of your letter to the Indian Agent at Prince Rupert with instructions to communicate with your Company giving the particulars of any cases where liquor is alleged to have been supplied by your Company to Indians in order that you may have an opportunity of co-operating with him in his efforts to suppress the liquor traffic among the Indians.
