Sir, - Your ref. No. 715

I have noted the provincial Gazette item relating to the cancellation of road through Boston Bar Indian reserve No. 2, as gazetted 23rd May 1929, but, unless it is necessary for your records, I do not consider that a transfer is necessary for this Department, inasmuch as this road, as gazetted, had not finally been approved by this Department and as Dominion Order in Council was not obtained authorizing its transfer to the Crown in the right of the Province, the fee had not passed from this Department to your Government. For your information, I may add, however, that when transfers are made to this Department title is transferred to the Crown as represented by the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs.
