Replying to yours of the 21st. inst. in connection with Chief Paul White of the Nanaimo giving his consent to the Nanaimo-Duncan Utilities to erect a power pole on the Indian Reserve at Nanaimo.

In regard to this I beg to advise you that this was an emergency case, as the Power Company was held up until they could get authority to place this pole on the reserve.

This matter was taken up before Mr Christianson Superintendent of Agencies, Mr Mackay Indian Commissioner and myself when visiting the Reserve, and the Chief was advised that it would be quite in order for him to consent, and when did, I was instructed to write the Company to this effect.

Under the above circumstances, please advise me if it will still be necessary to obtain the Bands consent.
