heavy if it is to meet this schedule. In order to help achieve this, I am suggesting that the House sit on the first two Wednesday evenings of the session. I shall accordingly move to that effect on Monday next. While it does not require a motion, I would also suggest that the House sit on Friday evening December 12th. If this does not suit the convenience of honourable members we might arrange to sit that day from 11 o'clock in the morning until 6 o'clock.

It is more than possible, I think, that it will be clear, by the end of the first week of the session, that the normal afternoon and evening sessions will not be sufficient to enable the programme I have outlined to be completed before the Christmas adjournment. In that event, I shall suggest that the House meet from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., in addition to the normal hours, beginning Monday, December 15.
