difficulty and opposition risked all, even life itself, for what they thought was right. We think also of the world's great mass of humanity who toiled unhonoured and unsung but who, by their Faithful Labours, laid the foundations of Empire, of whom the poet says:-

Perhaps in this neglected spot is laid;

Some hearts once pregnant with Celestial fire;

Hands that the rod of Empire might have swayed,

Or waked to ecstacy the Living Lyre."

As we think of these heroes of Faith in the past, our souls are inspired by what they did, by how they lived and for what they died.
