Go, and be crowned with the laurels of immortality. Go, and receive the reward of all thy toils, endurances and tears. Go, and bear the palm of victory in thy hands, have the name of God inscribed upon thy forehead, cast thy crown at the feet of him that loved thee and gave himself for thee, and join the enraptured hosts in saying, "Blessing, and honor, and glory, and power be unto him that sitteth upon the throne and unto the Lamb forever and ever." Thou didst enrich and ennoble earth with the strength of thy piety, the power of thy faith, the fervor of thy sympathy, the breadth of thy charity, and the depth of thy love. Go, now, and shine in the kingdom of thy Father as the brightness of the firmament and as the stars forever and ever. In thy absence, ALL ALONE is inscribed upon the choicest treasures of earth, but by faith we trace thy foot-prints up to thy heavenly home, and in strains feeble, though akin to thine, we join thee in saying, "Alleluia! Alleluia! for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth."
